



Storage:The lyophilized protein is stable at -20 °C for up to 1 year. After<br/>reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20 to -80 °C for 3 months<br/>or 1 week at 2 to 8 °C under sterile conditions. For extended storage, it is<br/>recommended to further dilute in working aliquots, avoid repeated<br/>freeze/thaw cycle.
