- Storage:The lyophilized protein is stable at -20°C for up to 1 year, the protein
solution can be stored at 2-8°C for up to 1 week under sterile condition.For extended storage, it is recommended to further dilute in a buffer
containing 0.1% BSA (make sure BSA will NOT interfere with your
experiment) and store in working aliquots at -20°C to -80°C for 6 months.
